We look forward to serving this community and offering the gift of healing to those in need."** Origin Biologics is focused on providing the highest quality musculoskeletal implants, which accelerate and restore biological and mechanical functionality of degenerative, diseased and trauma induced orthopedic and spinal defects.

By establishing a local tissue processing facility, Nevadans in need of these healing gifts will have increased access and expanded options available. **"We are making history, and I am honored to be part of it,"** says Origin Biologics Co-founder and Nevada Donor Network Chief Operating Officer, Simon Keith. **"This new facility brings tremendous opportunity to Nevada.
